### Grade 7 Supply List 2016-2017

#### Grade 7 Art (Mrs. Root)

Sketchbook (8 1/2" x 11" or larger hardbound - no spiral bound), 2 black sharpie pens, and a set of decent colored pencils.

#### Health 7 (Mr. Holmes)

1 folder with center prongs and side pockets

#### Health 7 (Mrs. Yager)

1 inch binder

#### Science (Mr. Richards)

One 2" 3 ring binder

Loose leaf paper (college ruled preferred)

One spiral bound notebook

Optional: TI 30X Scientific calculator (can use calculator from math)

#### Grade 7 Band (Mrs. Kerr)

1 inch 3 ring binder - black, and a plastic black folder to hold all of their music and handouts.

#### Grade 7 Spanish (Mrs. Bucci)

1 1/2 or 2 inch 3 ring binder

5 dividers

1 spiral notebook

2 red pens

1 expo marker

#### Grade 7 English (Mrs. Shea)

1 1/2 in binder (1" is fine, but other subject's papers are not to be kept in English binder)

1 pack of 5 or 8 tab dividers (8 tab is preferred, but 5 is acceptable)

1 package index cards

Loose leaf paper (college ruled)

Pens (blue or black ink only)

Pencils (#2)(and eraser is helpful)

A "jump", "stick", or "flash" drive (good size is 4GB...Your child's name should be the name in the device. If you need help with this, I will teach you how to change it.)





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### Grade 7 Physical Science (Mr. Minervino)

1 ½ - 2 inch binder

5 section dividers

Loose leaf paper, calculator, glue stick, pencil, highlighter

### Technology (Mr. Hingston)

Pencils, 1 pocket folder, 9 volt battery and a shoe box

### Grade 7 Art (Mrs. Moda)

**Pencils** – We will be using a pencil almost every day in class. If you are concerned you will forget to bring one on a daily basis, I will happily store them for you as long as they are clearly labeled with your name and grade. #2 pencils are fine; if you prefer drawing pencils that is fine too.

### Grade 7 Math (Ms. Yeostros)

Scientific Calculator (TI 30XIIS preferred)

1 plastic zippered pencil case or Ziploc storage bag with zipper

The following items should be in the zippered pencil case to **remain in the math class:**

Pencils, 6 in cm/inch ruler, 2 **JUMBO** glue sticks, 2 different color highlighters and colored pencils **or** crayons **or** fine tip color markers

1 box of tissues

Optional: Some students like the organization of an accordion style file portfolio to store math materials

Wish list to share: any of the items from the zippered pencil case, if anyone has access to free donated colored copy paper, I use it all year long for notes.

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
